

**Acute Rhinitis (nasal cold)**  
 An acute, progressive, infectious, purulent inflammation of the nasal mucosa and/or sinuses in the nasal cavity.

**Causes**

1. Viral (90% of all cases) caused by rhinoviruses (most common), adenoviruses, influenza viruses, etc.
2. Increased humidity, or other irritants (dust, smoke, etc.) in the nasal cavity.
3. Allergic reaction to various substances in case of hay fever and allergic rhinitis (nasal mucosa is more sensitive to infections).
4. Microorganisms that enter through the nose or sinuses.

**Symptoms**  
 The main symptoms are: nasal discharge (thick, yellow-green), nasal congestion, sneezing, itching, and redness of the eyes.

**Diagnosis**  
 The diagnosis is based on the history and physical examination of the nasal cavity and sinuses.

**Acute Sinusitis (infection of the paranasal sinuses)**  
 This is the most common infection of the paranasal sinuses. It is caused by the same pathogens as acute rhinitis.

**Causes**

1. Direct spread from the nasal cavity.
2. Spread from the middle ear.
3. Spread from the maxillary sinus.
4. Spread from the ethmoidal sinuses.

**Symptoms**  
 The symptoms are: nasal discharge (thick, yellow-green), nasal congestion, facial pain or pressure, and fever.

**Diagnosis**  
 The diagnosis is based on the history and physical examination of the nasal cavity and sinuses.

**Changes to the nasal cavity and the paranasal sinuses during sinusitis (nasal infection)**

**Changes caused by sinusitis showing the close anatomical proximity to neighboring organs**

**Diagnosis of sinusitis**

1. History and physical examination.
2. Radiological examination (X-ray, CT scan).
3. Endoscopic examination of the nasal cavity.
4. Laboratory examination of the nasal discharge.

**Chronic Sinusitis**  
 This is a long-term inflammation of the paranasal sinuses. It is caused by the same pathogens as acute sinusitis.

**Causes**

1. Acute sinusitis.
2. Allergic reaction.
3. Structural changes in the nasal cavity.
4. Microorganisms that enter through the nose or sinuses.

**Symptoms**  
 The symptoms are: nasal discharge (thick, yellow-green), nasal congestion, facial pain or pressure, and fever.

**Diagnosis**  
 The diagnosis is based on the history and physical examination of the nasal cavity and sinuses.

**Treatment of acute and chronic sinusitis**

**Acute sinusitis:** Treatment includes antibiotics, decongestants, and nasal irrigation.

**Chronic sinusitis:** Treatment includes antibiotics, decongestants, nasal irrigation, and surgery.
